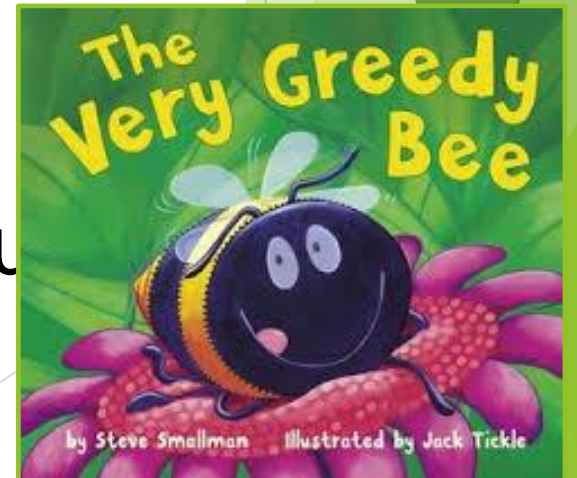
English Lesson 1

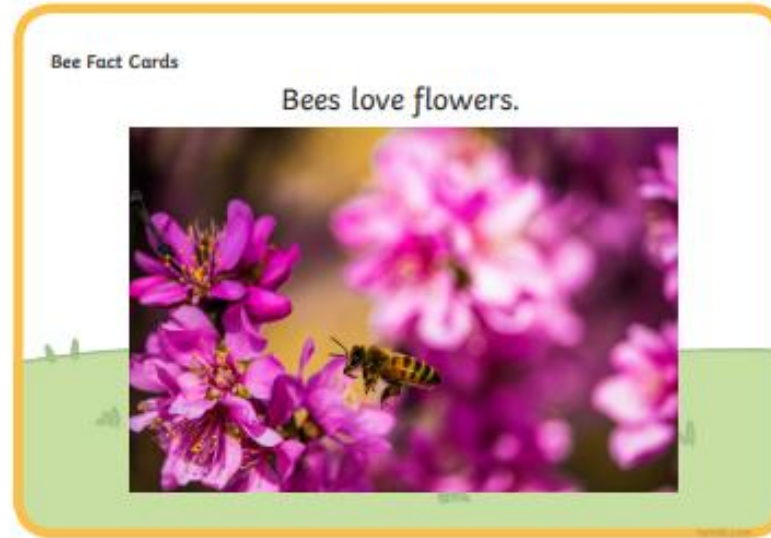

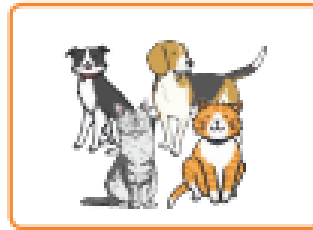
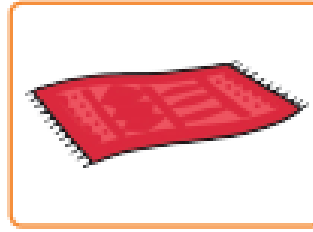
Discuss these fact cards with your adult. What new words have you learned?

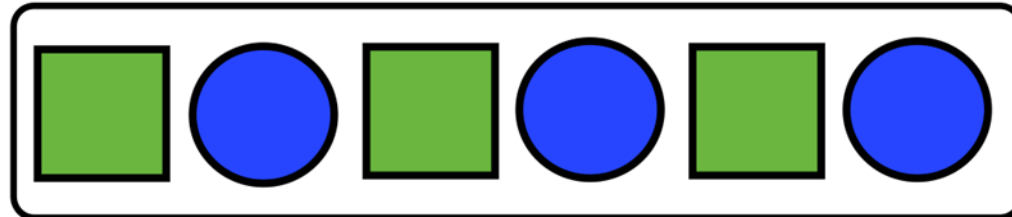

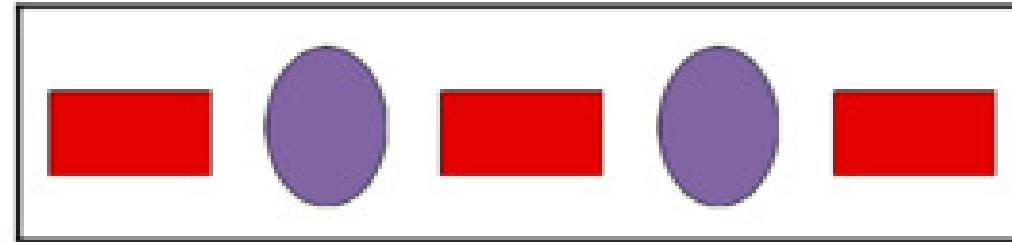

What shapes can you see in each strip?

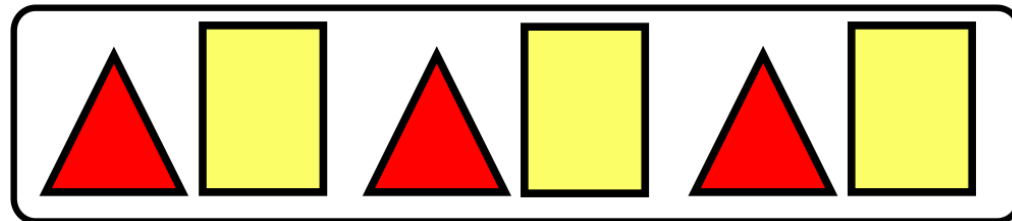


What is the repeating pattern?

Can you make your own shape repeating pattern?

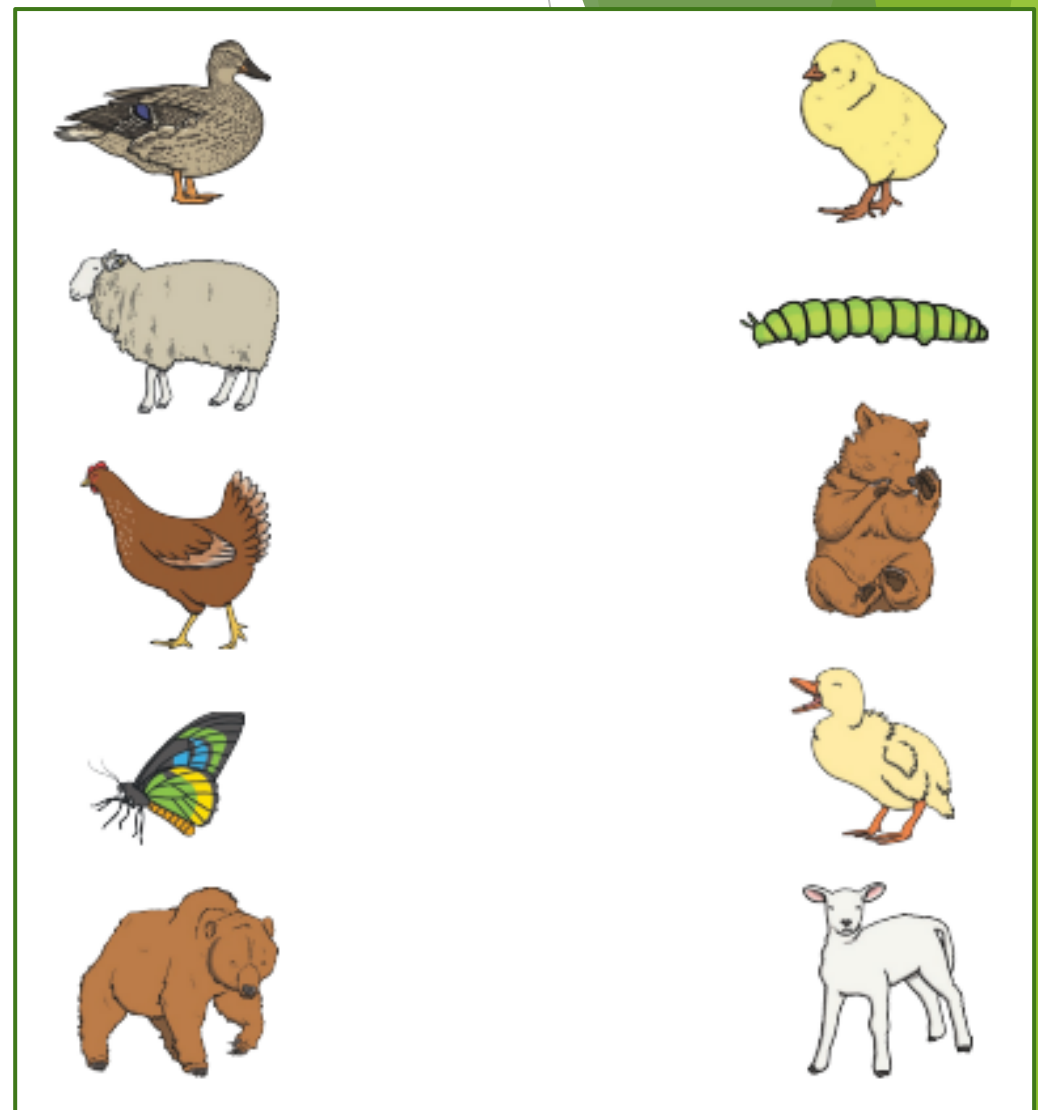

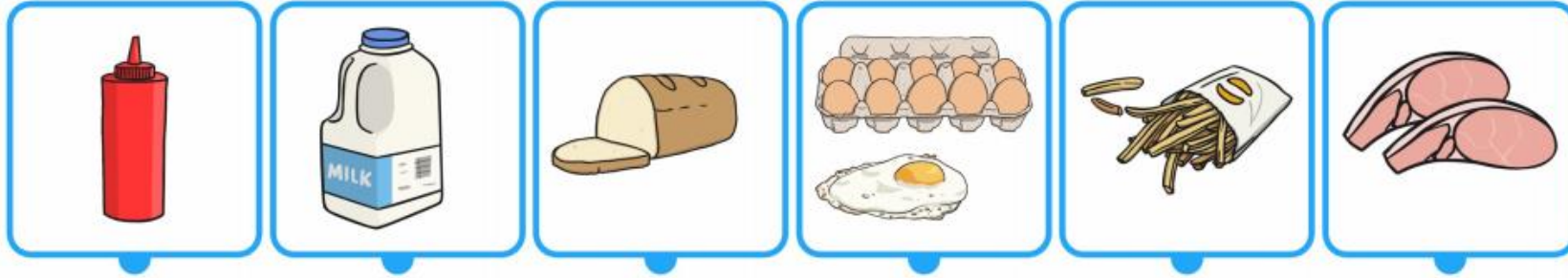
Can you name all the adult and young animals within the picture?

Can you talk about how the animals change or stay the same?

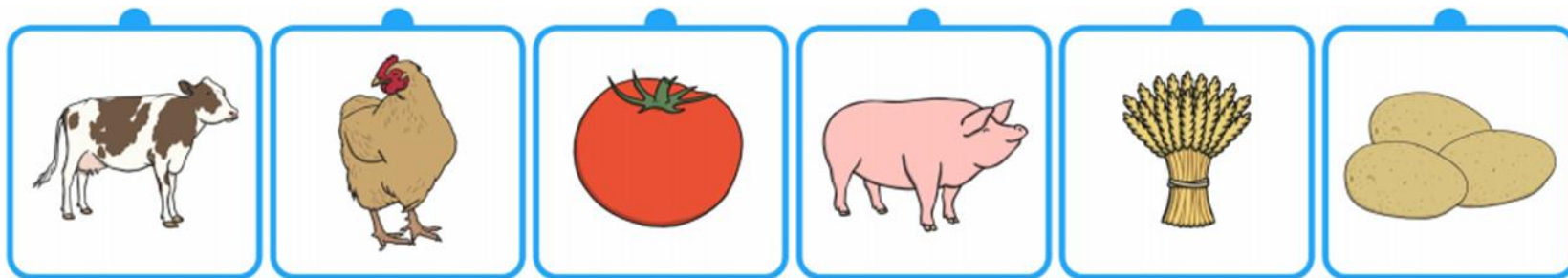
