Maths Lesson 1 Talking About Time

Ask your adult to help you name the days of the week.

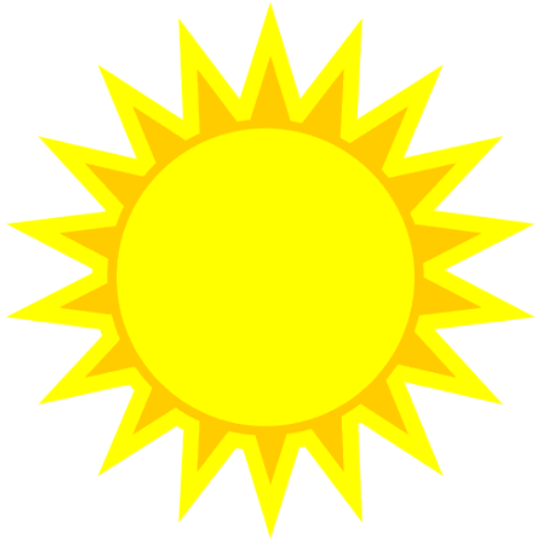
How many days of the week are there?

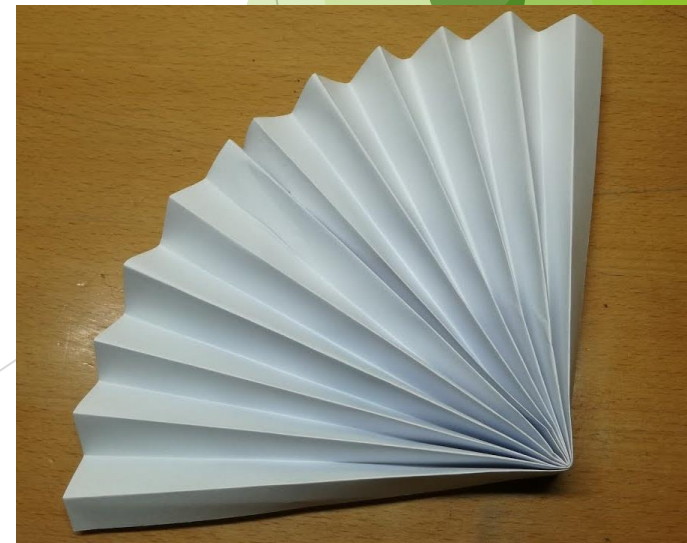


Topic Lesson 2 Make a Fan

Can you make a fan to keep you cool?

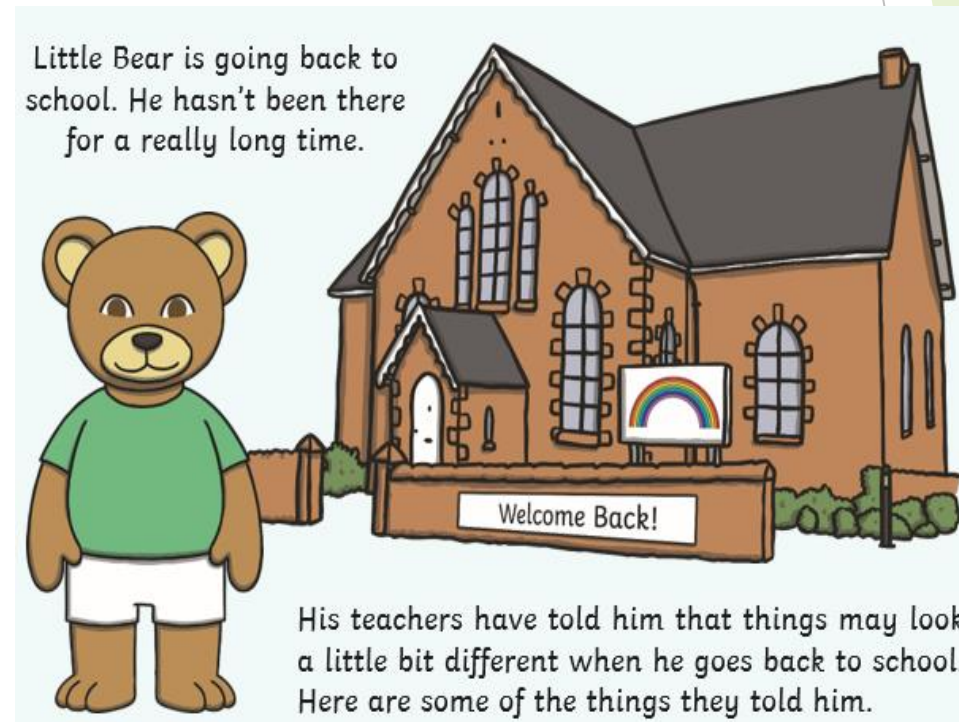
Decorate a sheet of paper or card with a summer design.

When you come back to school...

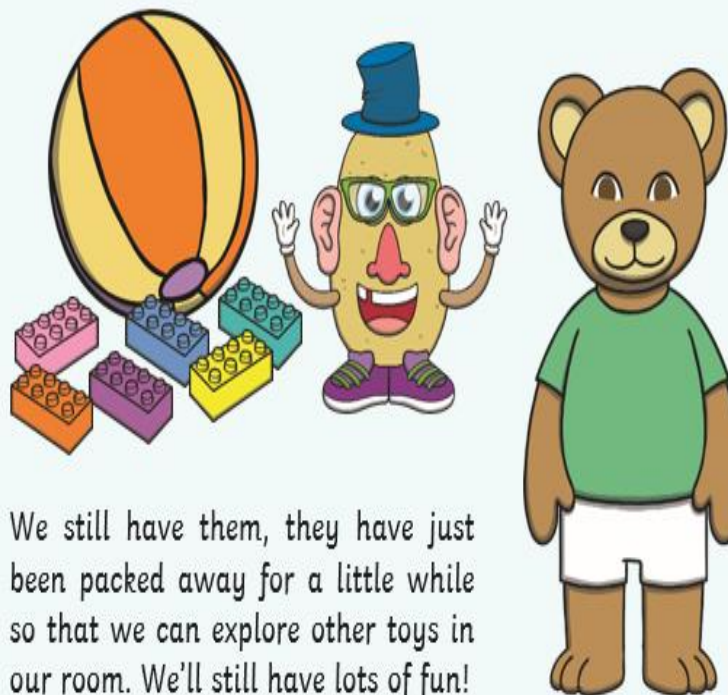
...the rooms may look a little bit different. The furniture might be in a different place and you might even be in a new room.
