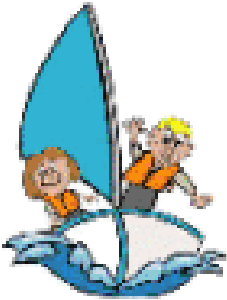

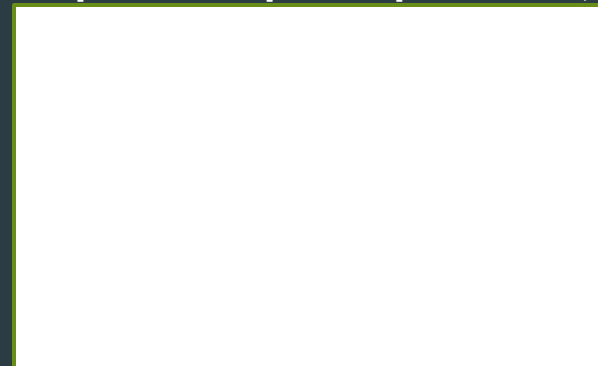
So the first job is to think of the things that you would like to learn, it might be to paint a picture, roller skate, learn how to say hello in 3 languages

Maths lesson 1

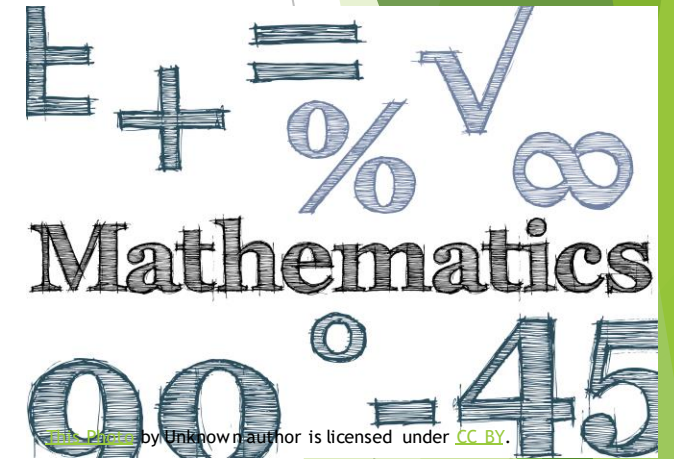
Make a spider diagram or a list of bullet points of all the topics we have covered this year in maths.

Now, create a maths poster about one topic. Make sure you give examples and explanations. This could help you next year in Year 7.



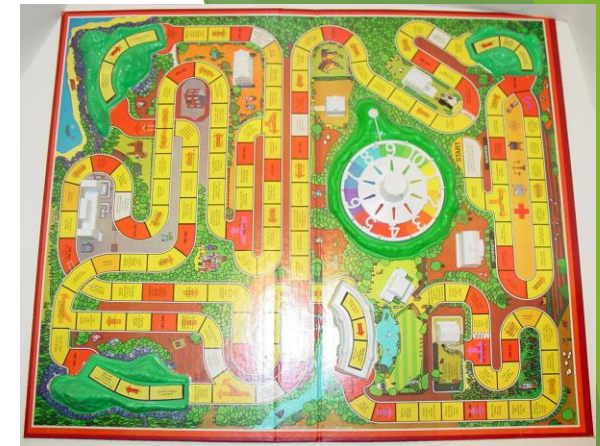
Maths lesson 2

Look at the list of topics from maths you created yesterday.

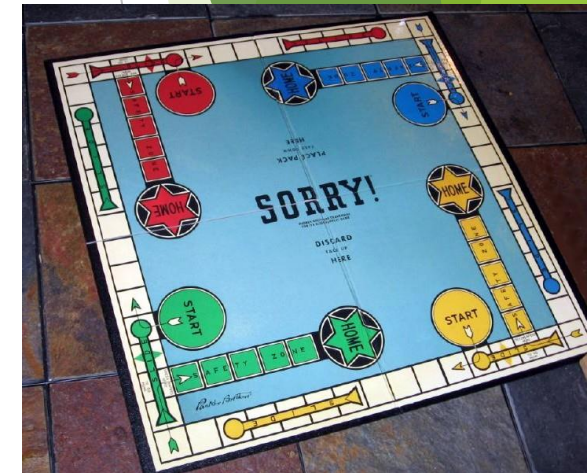
Using the topics in maths, you are going to **design** a maths game you can play with members of your household.
