Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	Can you act out the story using teddy bears from home? Have you got a large bear, medium and small bear? If not, can you make one? Can you use items from around your house as props?

Draw a picture of your favourite character and label them. Can you write a caption about your chosen character? Adults please upload your child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: To recognise the digraph 'oa'. Children will be taught the new digraph and will apply this to read words. Children will complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: explore counting in groups of five  Children will then complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	Can you make some porridge for breakfast at home with your family? Weigh out the ingredients and write step by step instructions on how you did this. What do you like to put in your porridge? Take a photo and upload to Tapestry.
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<b>Wednesday 03.02.21</b>	LT: form the graphemes Today we will be doing some handwriting practice. You will practice writing the graphemes of the new sounds we have learnt this week. We will model this together before you have a go at doing this on your own. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: To recognise the digraph 'ar'. Children will be taught the new trigraph and will apply this to read words. Children will complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: explore sharing objects into two equal groups  Children will then complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	Can you go for a walk with your family in your home like The Three Bears? Can you talk about what you have seen on your walk? How many steps do you think you will take on your walk?
