Following the Prime Minister's announcement we have been notified by Doncaster Council that we now have to move to remote learning immediately. We will be in contact tomorrow with details of the remote learning provision. We will send further details out about who will be able to access this provision from Wednesday 6th January 2021. Thank you for your ongoing support and understanding during these difficult times.

I will be working tonight to organise provision, so suggest that you put your phone on silent, as I will be sending our links to surveys through text.
