Children will be recap and revise the new digraph and will apply this to read words. Children will complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: Naming and describing the properties of 2d shapes. Today we will be recapping and developing our knowledge of 2d shapes. We will be using mathematical terms to describe these. We will be categorising objects by their shapes.	Can you make a story map for Little Red Riding Hood? There is an example in your home learning pack. Can you be creative and make your own?

<b>Wednesday 24.02.21</b>	Zoom calls will take place at the times above. Mrs Baxter and Mrs Binns will lead the calls and children are expected to attend. The link to the call will be texted to parents 10 mins before the session starts.			
	LT: To form the graphemes Today we will be doing some handwriting practice. You will practice writing the graphemes of the new sounds we have learnt this week. We will model this together before you have a go at doing this on your own. Adults please upload your child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: To recognise the trigraph 'ear'. Children will be recap and revise the new trigraph and will apply this to read words. Children will complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: Describing the seasons of the year Today we will be identifying features for each season of the year. Children will then complete the cut and stick activity matching the features to the seasons of the year (found in home learning packs).	Can you make the characters from the story into finger puppets and have a little puppet show?

Take a photo and upload to Tapestry.

Friday 26.02.21	LT: Write a simple sentence. We will look at key features of a simple sentence and what we need to remember when writing a simple sentence. Children will be show images from the story and they will think of a sentence to match the picture. Adults please upload your child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: To recap the new sounds this week. Children will be consolidating and developing their confidence in recognising the new sounds taught from the last 2 weeks. Children will complete the activity on Tapestry independently. Adults please upload their child's learning to Tapestry.	LT: complete subtraction within numbers to 10 Today we will be using a ten frame and will be developing our confidence with subtracting single digit numbers away from each other.	Can you make some binoculars and go on a hunt for tricky words and numbers?

- Please practice recognising numbers 1-20 and placing them in order. You can also match quantities to numerals.
