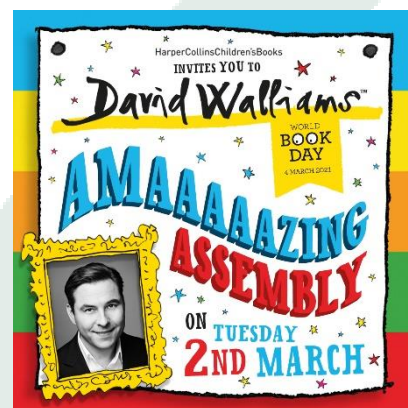

Importance of Reading Workshops – Monday 1st – Friday 5th March 2pm every day – Open to all:

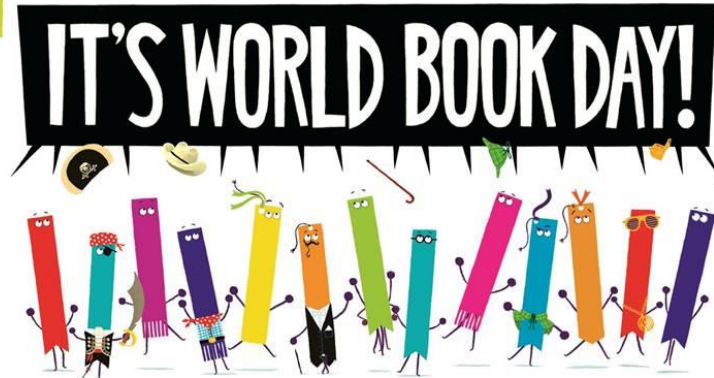
