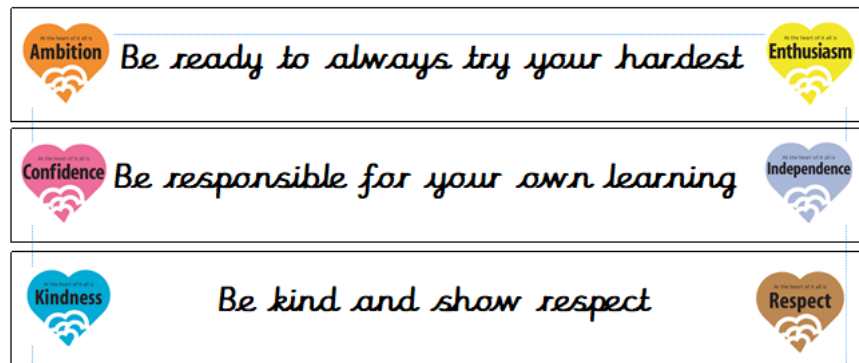
Weekly News
