Staff are already busy making arrangements for the new academic year.

We have previously communicated to parents that all classes will be mixed each year, albeit last year we did not do this to keep a level of consistency for the children due to COVID-19. Transition Week - Monday 12th July – Thursday 15th July

During the 4 days, the children will spend all day with their new class teacher. The theme of the week will be the Summer 2021 Olympics.

During the week we would like the children to follow the routines of their new year group. The main differences will be

Children should come into school in their PE kit on the following days:
