RE Safety measures for events

We have done so well since the children returned to school in March, with no bubble closures or cases reported. After a substantial decline in Covid 19 cases and deaths since the start of the year, the average number of daily confirmed cases is now rising. We want to ensure that all of our staff, children and parents remain safe, so want to share with you key information about the school C19 rules and routines for the remaining 4 weeks.

We are continuing to apply the guidance provided to schools [Schools coronavirus \(COVID-19\) operational guidance - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](#)

Our own risk assessment continues to be applied. However, following government guidance, we have started to relax aspects of the risk assessment when the event can take place outside.

We have a few events taking place in the summer 2 term which we feel can take place safely outside, with parents and carers in attendance.

Sports day – various dates

We are applying the guidance below and ask that parents and carers apply the guidance and rules below:

- Please maintain a two-metre distance from people that are not part of your household.
- Do not congregate in groups.
- There will be cones displayed in the 'watching' area for your family to sit behind.
- After the sports day has ended please allow us to take the children into the classrooms before you leave the field.

The children will remain in their bubbles and kept 2m apart if running in the same race.

Year 6 Celebration event on Friday 9th July

- Bring your own picnic blanket.
- Remain in your allocated picnic area, keeping separate from other families.
- Maintain a two-metre distance from people that are not part of your household.
- Do not congregate in groups.
