### **Assessments**

### **Year 6 Final Day Arrangements - Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July**

On this day, the Y6 children are invited to wear an old shirt for signing. We also invite those children purchasing a hoodie to wear it on this day.

We will be making this final day special for them. We will be holding a whole school 'special assembly' and have many more exciting events planned for them during the morning.

We are encouraging the children to bring a packed lunch to school on this day, as we would like to have a picnic for lunch. We will be providing extra snacks for the picnic.

From 1.15pm we invite Parents and Carers to come and celebrate with us.

We will be holding an award ceremony for the Y6 children, which will hopefully take place on the school field.

**Parents'/Carers should arrive from 1.15pm and be seated by 1.30pm.** We ask that you bring your own picnic blanket/seats to the event.

Entry to the field will be through the Wike Gate Road field entrance.

2 adults per family are permitted to attend the event. If your family situation means that you require more adults to attend, please contact the school to discuss this further.

Siblings who are not of school age may attend with parents. However, we ask that you leave the event (temporarily) if your child becomes unsettled and starts to disrupt the event.

The Y6 children will sit with their parent's/carers. We want everyone in attendance to be able to enjoy this event and therefore anyone creating a disturbance may be asked to leave.
