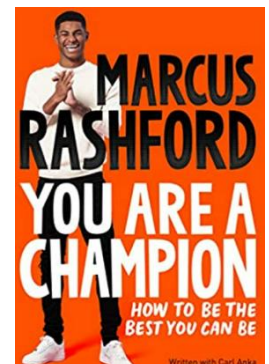
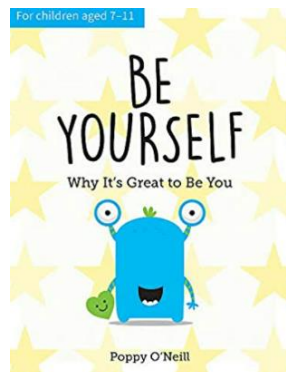
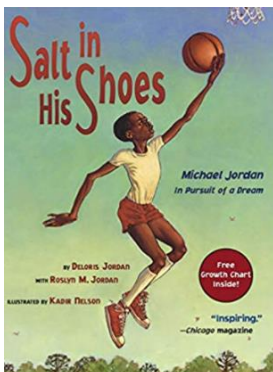
We have had a great first few days back at school. It was great to see the children return on Wednesday, and hope they enjoyed the pantomime 'Dick Whittington'.
