RE: Phonics Screening Check (PSC)

Please find enclosed the results of your child's Phonics Screening Check Assessment, which we completed recently with your child.

This assessment would usually have taken place in June, when your child was in Year One. However, due to COVID-19, the DFE extended this period until December; the first term of Year Two.

If your child achieved below 32, he/she did not pass the assessment. Please do not worry! Your child will receive daily phonics, to support him/her to pass the retest assessment. This assessment will take place during the Summer Term.

If your child achieved between 33 – 38, although he/she passed the assessment, he/she will continue to receive phonics support to address the gaps in learning that prevented him/her to achieve full marks.
