Re: Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium is funding to improve education outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in schools in England. Evidence shows that disadvantaged children generally face additional challenges in reaching their potential at school and often do not perform as well as other pupils.

Each year we publish a Pupil Premium Strategy, which details how we use this funding.

As your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, an overview of some of the key benefits to your child are listed below:

- Subsidised school jumper (50% off)
- Subsidised cost of school trips and events (50% off) *
- Breakfast club (free of charge) including 1-2-1 reading with a trained member of staff (dependent on level of need)
- 1 full day attendance at the holiday club (free of charge)
- Access to all after school clubs, between hours of 3 – 4pm (free of charge). This is subject to availability.
- Subsidised peripatetic music lessons (50% off, subject to availability)
- Lexia online access (dependent on need)
- Prioritised in-school support (dependent on need)
