## **Nursery – William’s Den Visit**

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our topic next half term is Adventure Awaits. For this, we will be going to William’s Den on Wednesday 4th May 2022. Due to this being their first school trip at a young age we are inviting all parents/carers to attend with them. If this is an issue and you cannot attend please speak to the school staff.

The coach will leave school just after 9:30am and return to school at 3:00pm. The children will need to wear school uniform. Weather dependent, your child may need warm clothing (coat, scarf, gloves) as well as a raincoat as there are lots of activities outside.

Your child and their adult will need a packed lunch on the day. Parents can either provide their child’s own packed lunch or can order one from the Academy by indicating in the notes section on Parentpay.

The cost of the trip is £27.50. This covers the cost of transport and the session at William’s Den for the child and their adult.

Parental voluntary contributions are welcomed for this trip. However the school reserves the right to cancel the trip should it consider the net cost after taking into account voluntary contributions, is uneconomic.

Without making a contribution your child will not have consent to attend the trip and therefore will not have permission to attend.

All contributions should be paid via Parentpay by Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2022. We will let you know on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2022 if the trip can go ahead with the contributions received.
