What is a PTA?

A PTA is a group of parents and school staff who meet to discuss areas of interest and priority to the school.

How often does the PTA meet, and when?

We will meet once per half term (6 times per year). However, the group may decide to meet more frequently. We appreciate how busy people are so ask that group members attend a minimum of one meeting per year.

Meetings are provisionally scheduled for the first Thursday in each half term. The meetings may be face-to-face or through Zoom, depending on the needs of the members. **Our first meeting in the new academic year is Thursday 8th September.**

What does the PTA do?

This can vary. It may include:

- Discussing ideas of how the school can improve
- Organising fundraising activities
- Volunteering to support events
- Sharing events with friends and family

What is expected from a group member?

- Attend a minimum of 1 meeting per year
- Share ideas and opinions in a positive way
