Mental Health Awareness Week

As part of Mental Health Awareness Week, children have been practising a 'feel better in 5' technique by Dr Chatterjee. This is great for calming the mind and looking after your mental health. Children have taken the time to draw and colour whatever they like, as long as it brought them happy thoughts. Did you know that colouring takes up all of your focus and is the easiest way to practise mindfulness?

At home this weekend you can try these techniques to 'feel better in 5' - they only take 5 minutes.

- Five minutes of flow: painting, drawing, colouring or listening to music
- Five minutes of general conversation: sit down in a clam place, make eye contact and sit attentively. Talk about each other's lives, about what they are thinking and feeling. Listen attentively and try not to interrupt.
- Five minutes of love list write down 5 things you love about someone else you're close to. You could also do this for things you love about yourself.
