Brooke Primary Academy Weekly News

We can't quite believe how fast the end of term is creeping up on us! We have had another busy, fun filled week!

This week and last our Y2 and Y6 teachers met with other local primary schools to moderate writing together. They were fantastic afternoons and Mr Moore, Mr Farrand and Mr Thomas felt very proud when sharing our books with other professionals.

At the beginning of the week, our whole school assembly was all about having tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs, which is one of the five Fundamental British Values. The children spoke to someone else in their class about how they were the same and how they were different and discussed how we always respect people's differences. The children enjoyed watched a clip from 'Birds on the Wire' and identified which characters were not being tolerant.

Y6 have been enjoying lots of visits from Trinity teachers to support transition. They enjoyed a visit from their Science team where the children had an exciting demonstration on dissecting a heart and examining a pluck (heart, lungs and trachea). This session enabled the children to build upon their learning about the heart and circulatory system from Spring Term. The Trinity staff were impressed at the knowledge, understanding and use of terminology demonstrated by the children.


