I hope this love for art and design continues during the summer holidays. Here are a few art and design activities that the children can complete:

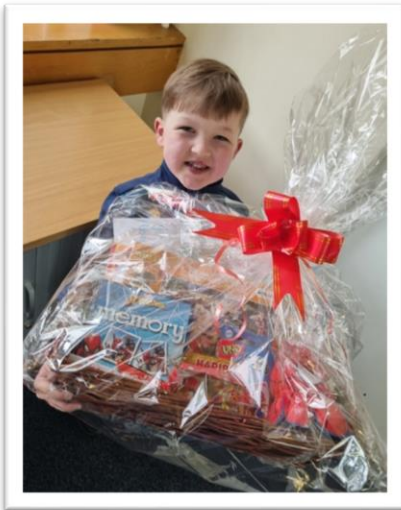
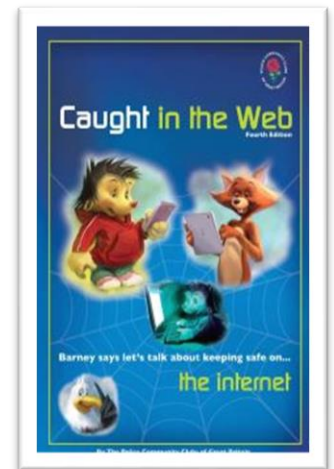


Year 6
