On Monday, Amy from the Doncaster Religious Education Team visited us to deliver a whole school Harvest themed assembly. We played a word game to collectively find all the words that are in the word harvest and learnt that at harvest time the most important word in harvest is 'share' as harvest is a time when we are reminded to share what we can with others. Amy also read a story to us about how it doesn't matter if we give a little or a lot to help someone but the most important thing is that we are helping others, she also asked some children and had some props to act out the story.

Tuesday 10th October was World Mental Health Day and the With Me In Mind team were delighted to attend Brooke Primary Academy where they held corridor workshops with both KS1 & KS2 during lunch time. They spoke to pupils across all classes and engaged in conversations with them about mental health. They specifically asked them to think of ways in which they can maintain or improve their mental health such as exercise and being kind to others. They asked the pupils to write down the different kinds of exercise and the various forms of being kind on post-it notes and stick them on their display board. The pupils were amazing at thinking of different ideas, and they loved sharing these with Mike and Lindsay from the With Me In Mind team. Mike and Lindsay were able to spend time talking to the pupils and explaining how exercise and being kind to others can reduce stress levels, lift our moods and help clear our minds.







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Year 4 - visit from the Doncaster Religious Education team

To finish our current unit of work in RE, Amy from the Doncaster Religious Education team came in to tell us how she uses the Bible as a practising Christian. For example, the ten commandments in Exodus Chapter 20 are rules for Christians to follow like we have class and school rules.

We found it very interesting that she re-reads parts of the Bible and that she has favourite books within the Bible and that there are some books in the Bible that she doesn't find very interesting. Amy also taught us that the word 'Bible' is a Latin word which means book, which is why Christians refer to the Bible as the holy book.



Year 3 – visit from Doncaster Mosque

Year 3 enjoyed a visit from the Doncaster Jamia Mosque on Wednesday. Our visitors talked about their role within their religious community. The children asked lots of thoughtful questions about believing in Allah.
