


Parents Evening


Attendance Matters

Attendance Challenge Winners - W/E 12/01/2024 (Spring 1, Week 2)


Attendance is at or above the school target of 96%

Lateness

Being late adds up to a loss of learning

- If you are 15 minutes late <u>every week</u>, this adds up to a loss of 3+ days of education every year
- If you are 15 minutes late <u>every</u> day, this adds up to a loss of 2+ weeks of education every year

How to help ensure your child arrives in school on time everyday

- get up early and make sure your child leaves the house on time.
- · prepare uniform and bags the night before
- attend breakfast club if needed (breakfast club opens at 07:45)
- if your child is unhappy or having problems at school, please ring to discuss these issues.

Arriving late to school may cause difficulties for your child

- it may be embarrassing walking into a class that has already started working
- it disturbs lessons, impacting other pupils
- missing even part if a lesson can make learning more difficult
- lateness contributes to your child having a poor attendance record
