We understand that emotions can run high in certain situations, especially when it comes to the well-being of your child. However, negative or disruptive behaviour not only affects the immediate situation but can also create a tense and a potentially unsafe environment for students, staff, and other families.

To ensure that our academy remains a safe and welcoming space for everyone, we ask that all adults:

1. Treat all members of the school community with kindness and respect, including staff, students, and fellow parents.
2. Refrain from using inappropriate language, shouting, or engaging in heated arguments while on school grounds.
3. Address concerns or issues with school staff in a calm and constructive manner, and through the appropriate channels.
4. Follow the school's guidelines regarding parking, pick-up, and drop-off to ensure safety for all students and families.
5. Report any serious concerns or incidents directly to the school office.
