Please provide your child with a packed lunch and a bottle of water on the day. If you require a school packed lunch made by school, please let the office know. No spending money is required.

Please make sure you arrive on time for school so we can get the register completed promptly. Please come to our classroom door as usual when dropping your child off in the morning and again to collect when we return.

The coach will leave school at 9:30am and will return to school at 3:00pm

The cost of the school trip is £29.00. Please may we ask that consent and payments are made on ParentMail by Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> May.

Parental voluntary contributions are welcomed for this trip. However, the school reserves the right to cancel the trip should it consider the net cost after taking into account voluntary contributions, is uneconomic.
